



2018 Estate Reserve Pinot Noir

Our Estate Reserve Pinot Noir consists of our very best clones of Pommard and Dijon 777. Potter's Vineyard was planted in 2001 at 700 feet elevation in the newly established Laurelwood District, a sub-AVA of the Chehalem Mountains and Willamette Valley AVA's in Oregon.

The 2018 vintage was one of those perfect weather years in Oregon with steady even heat, little pest pressure, and a beautiful dry but cloudy fall which allowed us to pick when we wanted to. Some rated it a 100-point vintage. We picked early to preserve the acidity and the fruit came in very clean with lots of classical red cherry, rich complexity, and smooth round tannins a defining characteristic of the new Laurelwood District.
